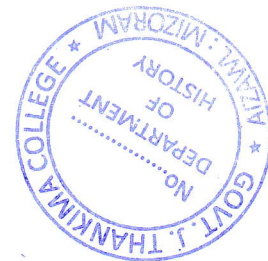


**Action Taken:** The department has taken into accounts all the basic requirements of the course and after a thorough research was done on other college syllabus, a new and improved syllabus proposal was prepared and is sent to the BOPS meeting through department representative.

2. Teaching and Learning – In this section, suggestions were made to improve based on the analytical score. It was discussed that the students need more exposure besides the textbook knowledge.

**Action Taken:** As prescribed by the syllabus and from the suggestions from the feedback, more exposure activities and programs were conducted to improve student's perception and knowledge in the field of business and the management course. Exposure visits/Industrial visits and Study tours to Mizoram Food Processing Research and Training Centre (MFPRTC), Seling and MULCO Ltd. Thuampui were organized during the year. Different programmes organized by the state government in relation to entrepreneurship development programs were also attended by the department during the year.

3. Mentoring and Guidance - The analysis shows that there is a need to improve on providing and referring text books and other study materials.

**Action Taken:** The department had made an improvement in this category by increasing the number of books collection in the college library and also recommend all the teachers to avail study materials in a printout form. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the strict lockdown enacted by the state government by the month of March, online classes were conducted for the remainder of the semester and study materials were made available in LMS and WhatsApp groups in the form of words, PDF and video format.
