## Brief History of the Department

- ◉ With the Amalgamation of the two Colleges, Lalhmingthnaga College (1992) and J. Thankima College (1994), the College was upgraded to a Deficit Grants in Aids Status on 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2002, and later in 2007, the College was provincialized under the name Govt. J. Thankima College.
- ◉ The Department of English was established with the amalgamation of the two Colleges in 2002 with 3 (three) regular faculty namely Ms. Lalhmunsiami Khiangte, Ms. Lalrinsangi Ralte and Ms. Maria Lalremruati as Head of the Department. Ms. Brenda Laldingliani Sailo joined as regular faculty in the year 2006, and at present the Department contains 6 (six) faculty with Ms. Ruth VL. Rinpuii who joined in 2016 and Dr. Lalthansangi Ralte who joined in 2019.

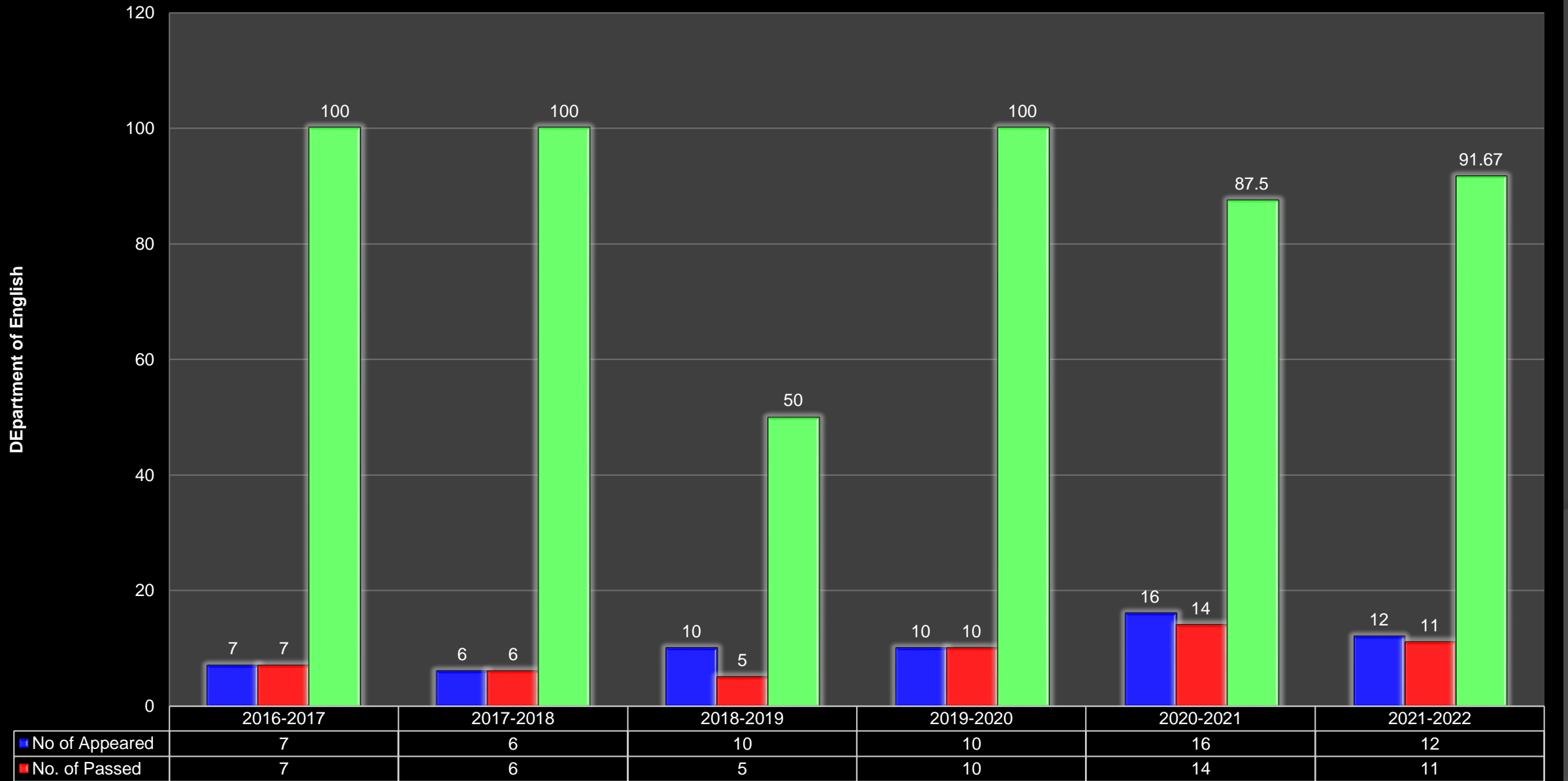
