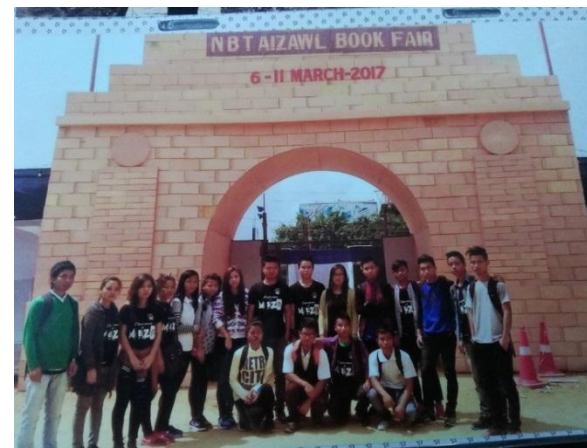
Recognition Awarded

- ▶ He was also Awarded 1st Prize in Art Competition on 19th December, 2019 organized by Asian Institution for Design, Bangalore.



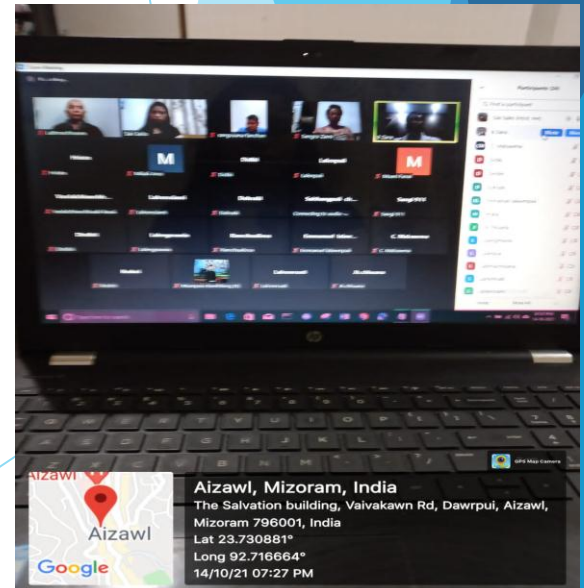
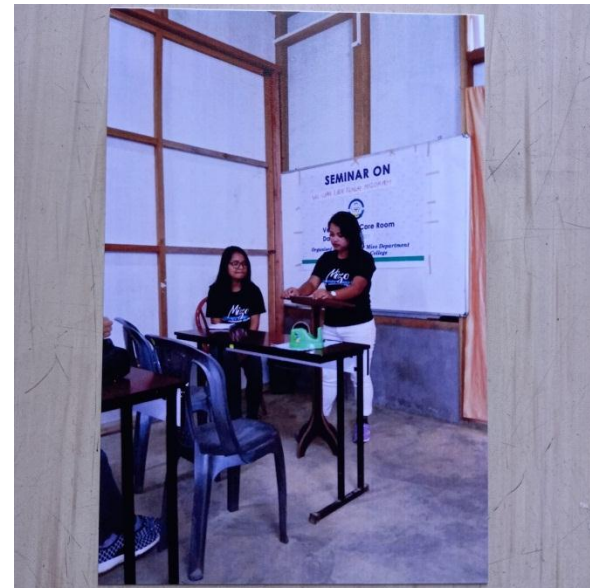
Departmental Activities

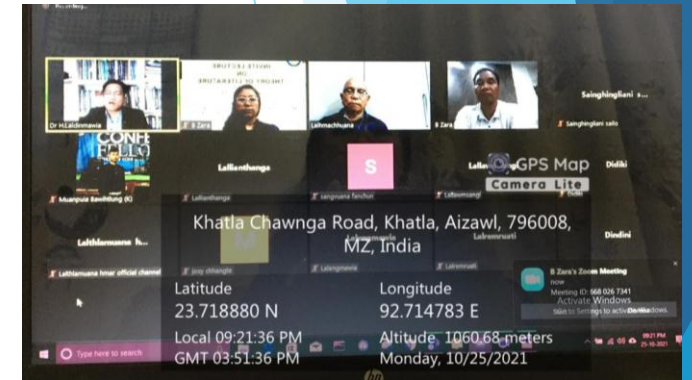
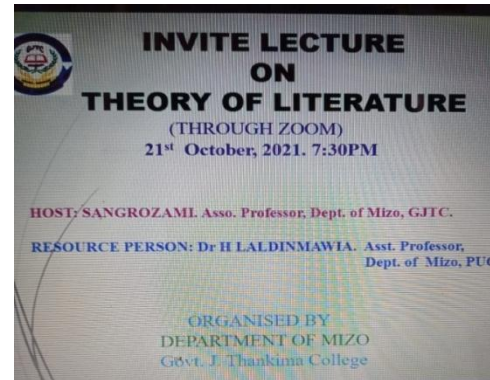

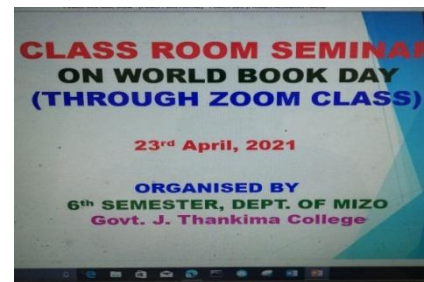


WORLD BOOK DAY:

- The Department observed World Book Day on 23rd April, 2021, through Zoom.

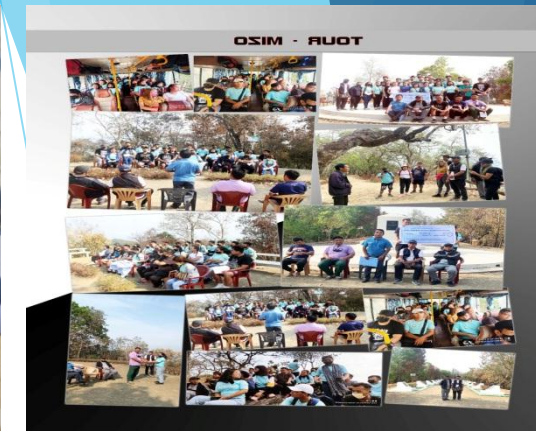

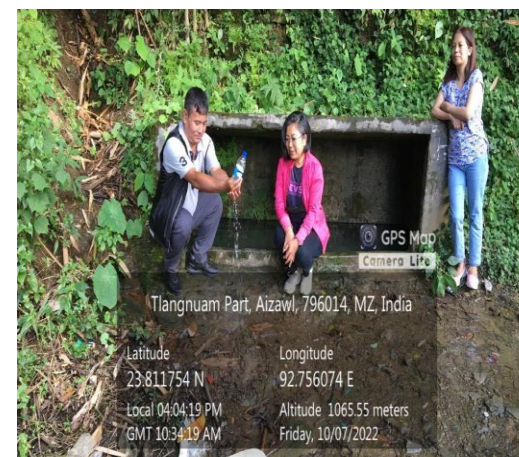
Departmental Activities

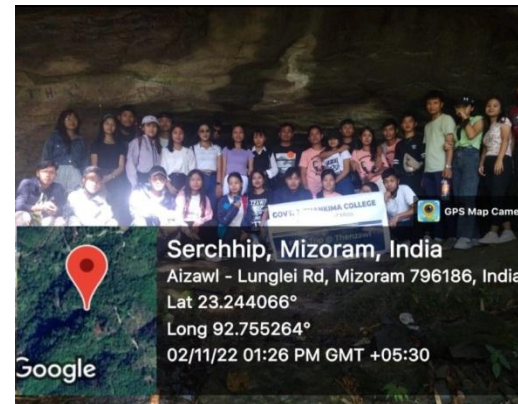
ACTIVITIES
