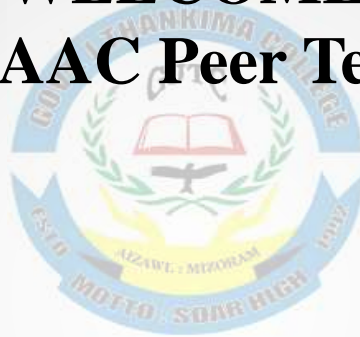

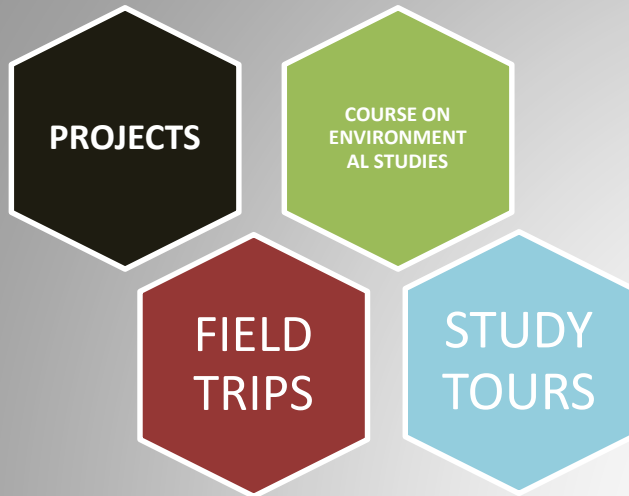

6. Home assignments: The Department also followed the prescribed format of home assignment writing prepared by the Department of Economics, MZU.

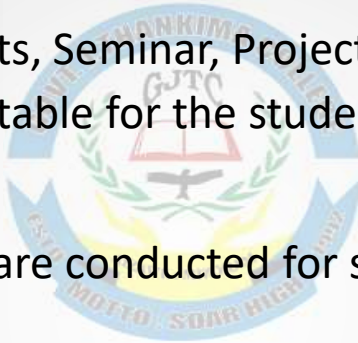
The department takes its students on **exposure trips, field-trips and study tours** for a broader concept of learning, knowledge and education.

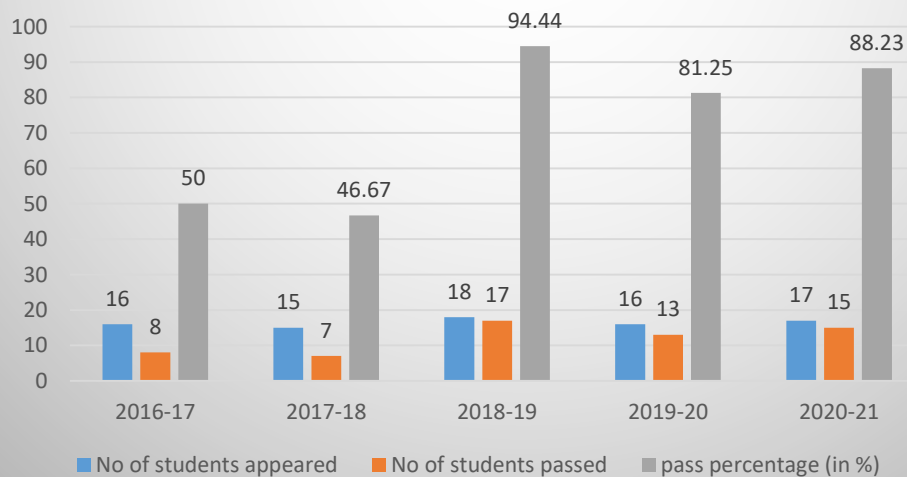

▪Strength :
