The questionnaire has been designed according to NAAC guidelines. It utilizes a Likert scale, where responses are given on a range from 1 to 5, with 5 representing the most positive response and 1 indicating the most negative response.

A total number of 119 students responses are then the representation of the survey. The data are represented as graphs, particularly in the form of pie-chart.




1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?








8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.




9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.




10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.






12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.












17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.




18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
