- If we take care of all such measures there can be effective implementation of the laws developed for their protection.
- The resource person also pointed out that domestic violence, harms or injures or endangers the health, safety, life, limb or well-being, whether mental or physical, of the aggrieved person or tends to do so and includes causing physical abuse, sexual abuse, verbal and emotional abuse harasses, harms, injures or endangers the aggrieved person with a view to coerce her or any other person related to her to meet any unlawful demand for any dowry or other property or valuable security.

She stated that women are protected from their abusers and can be given protection order, residence order, monetary reliefs and custody order. Protection officers, Service Provider and Counselors are always there to help these women.

• The lack of awareness of the law, and therefore the accessibility and awareness of services, types of relief, and legal rights, prevents proper implementation of the law. The resource person concluded that we must create a peaceful home environment in order to live in harmony. It is important that we work together to eliminate domestic violence from our home.

Outcomes:

- Attending a seminar has numerous benefits, gaining expert knowledge, networking with others and renewing motivation and confidence.

 Women who participate in self-defense training are less likely to experience sexual assault and are more confident in their ability to effectively resist assault than similar women who have not taken such a class.

Among many of the methods the resource person said, it included points like to stay aware, to listen to your gut, getting trained particularly for self-defense and using self-dense tools.

Teaching self-defense will equip women with the tools to identify and prevent violence from occurring to themselves and others, actively promoting peace one woman at a time.

Outcome:

The participants learned why it is necessary to learn to defend themselves, what they can do if they happen to be in a dangerous situation.

• They learned that it can be useful not only for them but for others too. They practiced some moves that they can apply in reality. It teaches students, discipline and confidence.

- They shared their experience during the wars and the struggles and hardship they had to face to protect their land.
- The students also find these to be very fascinating as it was a part of their syllabus and to hear it from the volunteers in person was a benefit for them.
- Corporal Zama, Ex. MNA had 11 works in 11 publications in 2 languages and 63 library holdings.
- They talked of the role of women in the road and journey to freedom, stressing on the relevance and importance of women in their struggle towards freedom.
- The role of women as medical attendants was also talked of in great length, mentioning them being the need of the hour.
- The resource persons for this seminar were volunteers during the insurgency and each shared their own experience.
- One of the resource people said that women's contribution to the formation of the state remains largely unrecognized.
- There were female volunteers in the MNF movement when the insurgency broke out in 1966. They fought bravely alongside the men and suffered with the men.
- However, there is no written record of the numbers of female volunteers in the movement even though hundreds submitted their names to the MNF movement.
- It has also been observed that eighteen women entered the underground camp in East Pakistan to serve as nurses and office staff and performed various supporting roles; some of them entered the battlefield to fight alongside men.
- The women who were left in the villages also experienced all kinds of exploitations during the armed conflict of the Indian government and the MNF movement.
- The enforcement of the Armed Forces Act of 1958 in the north-east brought great devastation on the lives of women.

Outcomes:

- Women suffered a great deal during the insurgency, many of which remain largely unknown.
- Their speech was very inspiring and informative.
