

In pursuance of the request of the Deputy Commissioner, Aizawl, an Awareness Campaign on EVM-VVPAT (*Electronic Voting Machine – Voters' Verifiable Paper Audit Trail*) under SVEEP programme was held at 1:30 PM today at the Central Campus. Students and staff of the Institution attending the Campaign casts their votes using EVM-VVPAT in the mock poll conducted by Maggie Lalmuanpuii, *Coordinator*, SVEEP and Vanlalduhsaka, the election officials from DC office.

Before the commencement of the mock poll, a brief lecture on the voting process using EVM-VVPAT was delivered by Vanlalduhsaka. While highlighting the purpose of their visit, Vanlalduhsaka said, "SVEEP or Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation is a programme launched by the Election Commission of India to address the deficit of voters in Indian elections. The aim of the programme is to inform and educate people about the importance of voting and to motivate the electorate to vote in elections. Hence, it is the duty of every law-abiding citizen of India to participate in elections to strengthen the foundations of democracy".

In the bid to increase voter turnout in elections, the Election Commission of India (ECI) is hoping to make Indian Democracy more participative through SVEEP. It started out as a small ECI activity before it was even given the name SVEEP. The programme was properly established and given its name in 2010. From 2009 to 2013, the phase covered over 17 General Elections to State Assemblies and even three revisions of the Electoral Roll and has been credited with the dividend of increasing voter turnout.

The objectives of SVEEP are as follows.

- Educating individuals about the importance of voting.
- Increase participation in elections through voter registration and turnout.
- Increase participation in terms of ethical and informed voting process.
- Consistent education about the democracy and voting process in India.

For managing SVEEP's activities at the college level, an Election Literacy Core Group (ELCG) has been been constituted comprising the following members.

(3) Altered state of consciousness which is only temporary and ultimately leads to addiction. The Three component models of life's meaning (Reker & Wong)

- 1) Cognitive component, which is about making sense of one's experiences in life.
- 2) Motivational component, that is about pursuit and attainment of worthwhile goals.

- 3) Affective component, which is about satisfaction and fulfillment. Achievement of goal brings satisfaction and development of positive attitude. Those in addiction cannot develop these components and as a result they cannot have a meaningful and purposeful life and ultimately develop meaninglessness and depression symptomatology. Ways to maintain abstinence and develop a drug-free lifestyle:
- 1) Keep in touch with supportive friends who are also trying to abstain from drugs.
- 2) Develop new hobbies.
- 3) Try having pets like dogs, cats etc.
- 4) Take part in social work.
- 5) Eat at regular meal time.
- 6) Engage in physical activities and sweat out atleast thrice a week.
- 7) Have regular sleep time. Outcome: The Webinar received a lot of positive feedback from participants. It was very informative, inspirational and encouraging for the students. Many questions were raised by participants during the interaction time and the resource person's experience and knowledge were evident from the responses he gave.



The expenditure is debitable to the head of account MZ/2020-2021 Special Camping First Instalment and shall be paid to the Principal of the concerned institution.

The expenditure per camper per day on board, lodging, conveyance, light, water, etc. and transportation should not be an average exceeding Rs.64/- (Rupees Sixty four) only other than expenses like pre-camp orientation, resource person, planning activities, evaluation may be met from normal fund. The maximum expenditure on 7 days camp would be Rs.450/- (Rupees Four hundred fifty) only. Rs.64/- per camper per day on boarding, lodging, transport, etc. is the outer limit and every effect should be made to keep the expenditure on the low side. The duration of the camp over 7 days should be so regulated that the total expenditure does not exceed Rs.450/- per camper.

In the case of camp in urban/slum, day camp are permitted wherever found absolutely necessary. In the camp the expenditure will be reduced substantially.

It is, therefore, felt that the expenditure on a day camp should ordinarily not exceed 50 of the expenditure on a normal.

The expenditure statement duly supported by relevant vouchers should be furnished to the undersigned in prescribed proforma within 7 days from the close of the camp.

Report on site selection for borewell at Bawngkawn M/S-II, Aizawl

1. Topography:

The topography of the area consists of hillstope which is dissected by small stream. The hill stopes are associated with folding and faulting.

2. Drainage System:

The drainage system for a particular area is governed mainly by the natural drainage course and topography. The drainage patterns of the area are dendritic to sub-dendritic patterns some of which follows linear features indicating fractures or joints.

3. Geology of the area:

Lithology (Rock types): The area is underlain by Middle Bhuban formation of Surma Group of Terriary age. Middle Bhuban formation is predominantly argitlaceous characterized by shale and siltstone. However, sandstone beds are also found. Hence, lithologically, the area is characterized by alternating beds of shale and fine-coarse grained sandstone.

Geomorphology: The area falls within Less dissected Structural Hill or Gentle Hill Slope in terms of geomorphic classes.

Geological structures: It was observed that the rocks within the area are traversed by few geological features like faults, fractures, joints, etc. of varying magnitude and length.

4. Hydrogeological Units:

Hydrogeologically, the area consists of Semi-consolidated Unit. The Semi-consolidated formations developed secondary porosity due to textonic disturbances.

In this type of terrain, the scope for ground water storage is limited mostly to secondary porosity like fractures, joints, etc.
