6. On 11th April, 2018 ECO-CLUB organized Tree Plantation at Central Campus for the second time to make it green and attractive college.
7. On 22nd April, 2018, The Mizoram ENVIS HUB organized the programme at Chite river to observe **EARTH DAY**. With the invitation of Mizoram ENVIS HUB along with others ECO-CLUB members from various school, more than 20 ECO-CLUB members were participated in this programme.

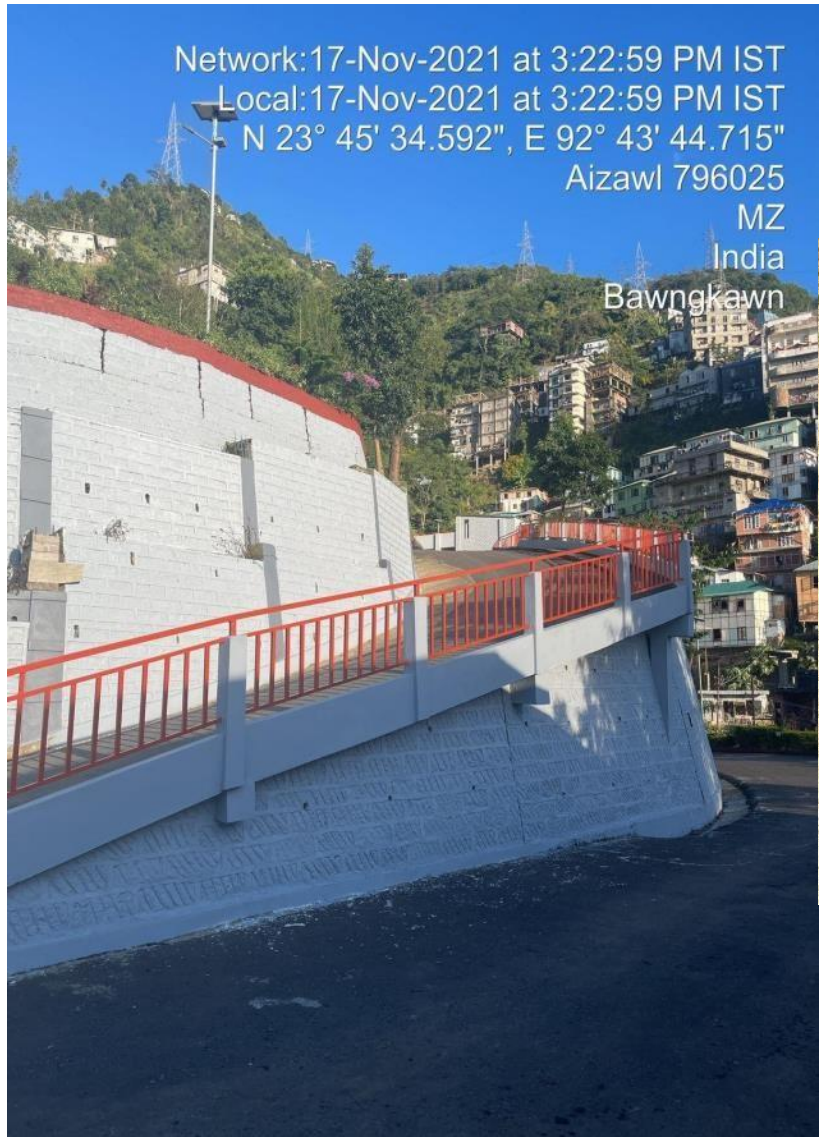

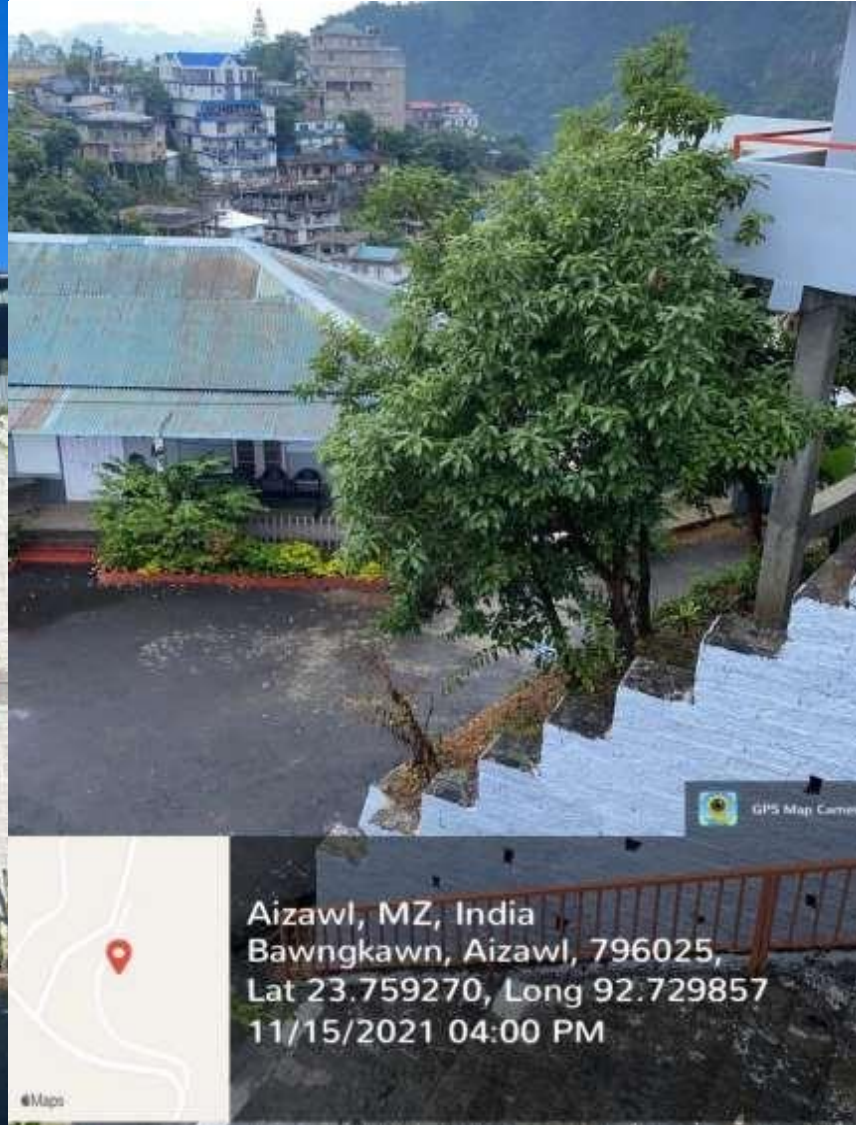

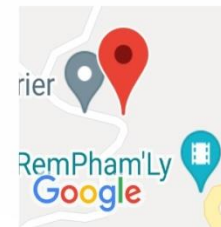
